Cygnet Chunky – Hedgehog

Materials

1 x 100g Cygnet Deluxe Chunky Stone 199 (MC)
1 x 100g Cygnet Deluxe Chunky Chocolate 297 (CC1)
Leaves
1 x 100g Cygnet Deluxe DK Lt. Mauve 1048 (CC2)
1 x 100g Cygnet Deluxe DK Sienna 508 (CC3)
1 x 100g Cygnet Deluxe DK Barley 4884 (CC4)
1 x 100g Cygnet Deluxe DK Juniper 1348 (CC5)
1 x 100g Cygnet Deluxe DK Regal 2566 (CC6)
1 x 100g Cygnet Deluxe DK Rain 3955 (CC7)

6mm Crochet Hook

Tension

Tension is not important as long as you maintain the same tension throughout.

Sizing

Approx. 17cm in height

Abbreviations

This pattern is written in UK Crochet terms

Rnd Round

Ch Chain

St Stitch

Dc Double Crochet

Dc2tog Work 2 dc stitches together; Insert hook in to next st, yo, pull yarn through, then insert hook in to next stitch, yo, pull through, yo, pull through three loops on hook.

Slst Slip Stitch

Place a stitch marker at the beginning of each row so you don't lose your place.

Hedgehog

With 6mm hook and MC.

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)

Rnd 3: *dc, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnd 4: *dc into next two sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (24sts)

Rnd 5: *dc into next three sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (30sts)

Rnd 6: *dc into next four sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (36sts)

Rnd 7: *dc into next five sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (42sts)

Rnd 8: *dc into next six sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (48sts)

Rnd 9: *dc into next seven sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (54sts)

Rnd 10: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 11: *dc into next eight sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (60sts)

Rnds 12-22: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 23: *dc into next eight sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (54sts)

Rnds 24-28: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 29: *dc into next seven sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (48sts)

Rnds 30-32: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 33: *dc into next six sts, dc2tog;
rep from * to end of rnd. (42sts)

Rnd 34: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 35: *dc into next five sts, dc2tog;
rep from * to end of rnd. (36sts)

Rnd 36: *dc into next four sts, dc2tog;
rep from * to end of rnd. (30sts)

Rnd 37: *dc into next three sts,
dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd.
(24sts)

Fix eyes between rows 30 and 31
approximately 2.5cm apart.

Stuff and continue to stuff as you go.

Rnd 38: *dc into next two sts, dc2tog;
rep from * to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnd 39: *dc into next one sts, dc2tog;
rep from * to end of rnd. (12sts)

Rnd 40: *dc2tog; rep from * to end of
rnd. (6sts)

Thread yarn through these 6 sts and
pull tight to close the opening.

Snout

With 6mm hook and MC.

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from
hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form
a ring. (6sts)

Rnd 2: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 3: 2dc into each dc around.
(12sts). Fasten off.

Ears

Make 2

With 6mm hook and MC.

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from
hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form
a ring. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around.
(12sts)

Rnd 3: Dc in to each st.

Fasten off

Feet and Arms

Make 4

With 6mm hook and MC.

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from
hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form
a ring. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around.
(12sts)

Rnds 3 - 6: Dc in to each st.

Fasten off

Spikes

With 6mm hook and CC1.

Spike 1: ch8, slst into 2nd ch from
hook, slst in next 6 ch sts.

Spikes 2 – 210: ch9, slst into 2nd ch
from hook, slst in next 6 ch sts.

Leaves

Make 6 one in each colour: CC2, CC3,
CC4, CC5, CC6, CC7.

With 6mm hook Ch 7

Rnd 1: sl st in 2nd ch from hook, dc,
htr, tr, tr, 6tr, working on other side,
tr, tr, htr, dc, slst.

Fasten off.

Rejoin yarn at top of the 6dc and ch4,
slst in 2nd ch from hook, slst in next 2
ch, fasten off.

To make Up

Take the spike and join to the top of
the hedgehogs head at the center,
bring it down the side of the body
attaching as you go until the reach
the center of the base, continue
attaching up the other side until you
reach the top again and then
continue to attach working in a spiral

until the back is covered and you
have reached the middle of the back.
For the ears fold in half and join the
edge together to create a crescent
ear chape and attach the joined edge
the ears just in from of the spikes.
Lightly stuff the snout and attach in
the center just below the eyes. Using
a small amount of CC1 sew on a little
nose in the center of the snout.

For the arms and feet fold in half and
join the edge together attach the
edge to either side of the body just
below the snout for the arms and at
the base for the feet.

Take the leaves and divide in to 2
piles and attach with a single stitch to
either hand.

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
