



# CY1849 SLIPOVER SUPERWASH DK

# **MEASUREMENTS**

To Fit Bust (Actual Measurement) 92 cm (36) in and 97 cm (38) in

# **MATERIALS**

Cygnet Pure Wool Superwash DK shades: Gold 2155 (M) x 2 100g balls and Bluebell 2156(C) x 1 100g ball

The quantities of yarn stated are based upon average requirements and are therefore approximate.

#### Tension:

24 sts and 24 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, measured over fairisle pattern using 4 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

## VERY IMPORTANT: IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

If there are less stitches and rows to 10cm, 4in, than the number stated, change to a finer needle, if there are more stitches and rows than stated change to a larger needle.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes.

Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

Owing to photography and printing restrictions, the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn.

## **Knitting Needles:**

1 pair of 3.25 mm (UK 10 – US3) and 4 mm (UK 8 - US6)

Stitch Holders

#### **Abbreviations:**

alt alternate	<b>inc</b> increase(ing
---------------	-------------------------

<b>beg</b> beginning	in(s) inch(es)	st(s) stitch(es)

rs right side g grammes

Note: When working fairisle pattern, carry yarn loosely across back of work keeping fabrics elasticity. Carry yarns not in use loosely up side edge of work.

## **FRONT**

Using smaller needle and M, cast on 91[97] sts and work 8 cm in K1, P1 rib, ending with a rs row.

Inc Row: P2[5], \* P into front and back of next st, \* P4, P into front and back of next st, rept from \* to last 3[6] sts, P3[6].

109[115] sts. Change to larger needle.

# **Commence Patt**

1<sup>st</sup> row: (rs) K3M, \* 1C, 5M, rept from \* to last 4 sts, 1C, 3M.

2<sup>nd</sup> row: P2M, \* 3C, 3M, rept from \* to last 5 sts, 3C, 2M.

3<sup>rd</sup> row: as 1<sup>st</sup> row.

4th row: \* P1C, 5M, rept from \* to last st, 1C.

5<sup>th</sup> row: K2C, \* 3M, 3C, rept from \* to last 5 sts, 3M, 2C.

6th row: as 4th row.

These 6 rows form the patt.

Cont in patt until Front measures 26.5 cm (10 ½ in) from beg, ending with a ws row.

# **Shape Armholes**

Keeping patt correct cast off 6 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 97[103] sts Dec 1 st at each end of every row until 89[91] sts then on every alt row until 81[83] sts rem. \*\*

Cont in patt until armhole measures

15 cm (6 in) ending on a ws row.

## **Shape Neck**

**Next row:** Patt 33[34], turn and work on these sts only.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on every row until 24[25] sts rem then on every alt row until 21[22] sts rem, finishing at armhole edge.

## **Shape Shoulder**

Cast off 7[8 sts at beg of next row and 7[8] sts at beg of following alt row.

Work one row then cast off rem 7 sts.

With rs facing, slip next 15 sts onto a holder, rejoin yarns to rem sts and patt to end.

Complete to match first side.

#### **BACK**

Using M, cast on and work rib as given for Back. 109[115] sts.

Change to larger needle.

Now work entirely in stst using M throughout to \*\* on Front.

Cont until armholes measure same as Front to Shoulders, ending on a ws row.

## **Shape Shoulders and Back of Neck**

**Next row:** cast off 7 sts, K17[18] including st on needle, turn and work on these last set of sts.

1st row: P2tog, P to end.

**2nd row:** Cast off 7[8] sts, patt to last

2 sts, K2tog.

**3rd row:** as 1<sup>st</sup> row. Cast off rem 7 sts.

With rs facing, slip next 33 sts onto a holder, rejoin yarns to rem sts and patt to end.

Complete to match first side.

## **NECKBAND**

Join right shoulder seam.

With rs facing, using smaller needles and M, pick up and K24 sts evenly down left front neck, K across sts on st holder dec 2 sts evenly across, pick up and K24 sts up right front neck, pick up and K5 sts down right back neck, K across sts on holder at centre back inc one st at centre, pick up and K5 sts up left back neck.

105 sts.

Work 8 rows in K1, P1 rib. Cast off in rib.

## **ARMBANDS**

Join left shoulder and neckband seam. With rs facing, using smaller needles and M, pick up and K118 sts evenly all around armhole.

Work 8 rows in K1, P1 rib.

Cast off in rib.

# **FINISHING OFF**

Join side seams.
