The quantities of yarn stated are based upon average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION:

22 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, measured over stocking stitch using 4 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

VERY IMPORTANT: IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

If there are less stitches and rows to 10cm, 4in, than the number stated, change to a finer needle, if there are more stitches and rows than stated change to a larger needle.

NOTES: Instructions are given for 45 cm, $17 \frac{1}{2}$ in chest, larger sizes are given in brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes.

Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

Owing to photography and printing restrictions, the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn.

Knitting Needles:

1 pair of 3.25mm (UK 10 – US3)

1 pair of 4mm (UK 8 – US 6)

4mm circular needle

3.25mm circular needle (optional)

Accessories:

6[6:6:6:7:8] buttons Stitch Holders Small Crochet Hook for Bobbles

Abbreviations:

BACK

With 3.25mm needles and Col A, cast on 48[54:58:62:68]sts and work 6 rows in K1, P1 rib.

Break off A, join in B.

Change to 4mm needles and cont in stst (knit rs, purl ws) until Back measures12[14:16:17:18]cm ending with a ws row.

Armhole Shaping

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2rows. (44[50:54:58:64]sts).

Work 6[8:10:12:14] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 38[42,44,46,50] sts ending with a ws row. Slip rem sts onto a stitch holder.

LEFT FRONT

With 3.25mm needles and Col A Cast on 22[25:27:29:32]sts and work 6 rows in K1,

P1 rib.

Break off A, join in B.

Change to 4mm needles and cont in stst until Left Front measures 12[14:16:17:18]cm ending with a ws row.

Armhole Shaping

Next row: cast off 2 sts, knit to end. 20[23,25,27,30]sts

Next row: purl

Work 6[8:10:12:14] rows dec 1 st at beg of next and every foll alt row. 17[19:20:21:23]sts ending with a ws row. Slip rem sts onto a stitch holder.

RIGHT FRONT

With 3.25mm needles and Col A, cast on 22[25:27:29:32]sts and work 6 rows in rib.

Break off A, join in B.

Change to 4 mm needles and cont in stst until

Right Front measures 12[14:16:17:18]cm ending with a rs row.

Armhole Shaping

Next row: cast off 2 sts, purl to end.

20[23,25,27,30]sts

Next row: knit

Work 6[8:10:12:14] rows dec 1 st at beg of next and every foll alt row. 17[19:20:21:23]sts ending

with a ws row.

Slip rem sts onto a stitch holder.

SLEEVES (Both alike)

With 3.25mm needles and Col A, cast on

42[46:52:58:62]sts and work 6 rows in rib.

Break off A, join in B.

Change to 4mm needles and work 2 rows in stst.

Cont in stst inc 1 st at each end of next and foll alt row. 46[50:56:62:66]sts.

Armhole Shaping

Cast off 2sts at beg of next 2 rows.

42[46:52:58:62]sts

Work 6[8:10:12:14] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 36[38:42:46:48]sts ending with a ws row. Slip rem sts onto a stitch holder.

YOKE

With 4mm circular needle and Col A,

k17[19:20:21:23]sts from Right Front stitch holder, k36[38:42:46:48]sts from Sleeve stitch holder, k38[42:44:46:50] sts from Back stitch holder, k36[38:42:46:48]sts from other Sleeve stitch holder and k17[19:20:21:23]sts from Left Front stitch holder.

(144[156:168:180:192]sts).

Next row: purl

Next row: k5, k2tog,* k10, k2tog;rep from * to last

5 sts, k5. (132[143:154:165:176]sts)

Next row: purl

Next row: knit

Next row: purl

Next row: k4, k2tog, * k9, k2tog; rep from * to

last 5 sts, k5. 120[130:140:150:160]sts.

Next row: purl

Continue working from Chart for 12[13:14:15:16] repeats, noting decreases until 48[52:56:60:64]sts rem.

NECKBAND

Change to 3.25mm circular needles and Col D (or straight needles if you don't have a circular).

Next row: purl. Work 4 rows in rib. Cast off loosely in rib.

BUTTONHOLE BAND

With 3.25mm needles and Col D pick up and k64[66:70:78:86]sts evenly up Right Front edge.

Next row: purl.

Work 2 rows in rib.

Next row: rib 2[4:5:4:2], * yo, k2tog, rib 8; rep from * to last 4[4,5,4,4] sts, yo, k2tog, rib 2[2,3,2,2].

Work 2 rows in rib.

Cast off in rib.

BUTTON BAND

With 3.25mm needles and col D pick up and k 64[66:70:78:86]sts evenly down Left Front edge.

Next row: purl. Work 5 rows in rib. Cast off in rib

BOBBLES

Using col D and the crochet hook, insert hook into centre of each diamond and work 6 chains. Fasten off leaving a long end to twist and secure chains into a bobble, pull the yarn end through to ws of work and secure tightly.


MAKING UP

Join sleeve and side seams. Sew in loose ends. Attach buttons.

This garment can also be worn as a sweater.
