



CY1905 BREEN SCARF

Materials

2 100g balls Cygnet Breen DK shade 3444 Northern Lights

 $Owing \ to \ photography \ and \ printing \ restrictions, the \ colour \ reproduction \ is \ matched \ as \ closely \ as \ possible \ to \ the \ yarn$

A long pair of 4 mm (US6) knitting needles or a circular needle.

TENSION 19 sts and 38 rows to 10 cm, 4 ins measured over garter stitch on 4 mm needles. If fewer stitches are obtained use a thicker needle, if more use a thinner needl

ABBREVIATIONS

K knit cm centimetres yo yarn over needle

st(s) stitch(es)Inc'd increasedrept repeatws wrong sidein inchesrs right side

Garment is made by increasing one stitch either side of the centre stitch on rs rows and also one stitch at each end of work on every row. A marker can be placed on this centre stitch on rs for guidance.

Cast on 9 sts

Foundation Row 1: (rs) K1, yo, k3, yo, k1 (centre st) yo, k3, yo, k1. 13 sts

Foundation Row 2: K1, yo, k to last st, yo, k1. 15 sts

Row 1: K1, yo, k to centre st, yo, k1, yo, k to last st, yo, k1. 4 sts inc'd.

Row 2: k1, yo, k to last st, yo, k1. 2 sts inc'd.

Rept rows 1 and 2 another 8 times. 69 sts

Row 19: K1, yo, * K2tog, yo, rept from * to 1 st before centre st, k1, yo, k1, yo, k1, * K2tog, rept from * to last st, yo, k1. 4 sts inc'd.

Row 20: k1, yo, k to last st, yo, k1. 2 sts inc'd.

Rept rows 1 to 20 until 2 balls of yarn have almost been used, keep some spare yarn for making 2 Tasssles. Cast off.

Darn in any loose ends.

Make two large Tassles for each end. Attach firmly.
