



# CY1888 Baby Striped Slipover And Bootees Kiddies Supersoft 4 Ply

# Measurements

**To Fit Chest** 16[18 ½ :20 ¾ ] in 41[47:52] cm

Materials

One 100g ball of Kiddies Supersoft 4 Ply in shades 258 Baby Blue (M) and 351 Mint (C)

A circular needle size 3 mm (UK 11) 16 or 24 in long (40 or 60 cm)

A pair of straight needles size 3 mm (UK 11) or larger for Bootees

4 small buttons for Slipover

The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate

# TENSION

28 sts and 36 rows to 10 cm, 4 ins measured over stocking stitch on 3 mm needles. IT IS IMPORTANT TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT MEASUREMENTS If fewer stitches are obtained use a thicker needle, if more use a thinner needle

# SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Rib: \* K2, P2, rept from \* Stripes: \* 2 rounds/rows in C, 2 rounds/rows in M

# BODY

With M, cast on 114[130:146] sts onto circular needle. Work 3 cm in 2 x 2 rib. Work in stripes as above in Special Instructions. PM at beg of round and also after 57[65:73] sts. When piece measures 15[16:17] cm, cast off 8 sts each side for armholes. (ie 4 sts on each side of both markers).

# BACK (worked over 49[57:65] sts)

Cast off 2 sts at each side 3 times and one st 2[3:3] times for armholes. 33{39:47] sts. When piece measures 23[25:27] cm, cast off the middle 19[21:25] sts for neck and finish each shoulder separately. Cont to cast off 2 sts on next row from neck until 5[7:9] sts rem. Cast off when piece measures 24[26:28] cm.

# FRONT (worked over 49[57:65] sts)

Cont to cast off for armholes in each side as for Back AT SAME TIME when piece measures 20[22:23] cm, slip centre 9[11:15] sts onto a holder for neck and finish each shoulder separately. Cont to cast off for neck at beg of every row from neck 2 sts twice and one st 3 times. 5[7:9] sts. When piece measures 24[26:28] cm, cast off.

#### FRONT NECK EDGE

With RS facing and using M, pick up and K48[60:68] sts including sts on st holder at front (divisible by 4) along the neckline at the front. With back and forth in 2 x 2 rib for 2 cm. Cast off loosely in rib.

#### BACK NECK EDGE

With RS facing and using M, pick up and 36[40:44] sts (divisible by 4) along neckline at back and work rib as for front.

# **ARMHOLE EDGES**

With RS facing and using M, pick up and K76[84:88] sts (divisible by 4) along one armhole. Work rib back and forth as on neck edge. Repeat along other armhole.

# FRONT SHOULDER EDGE

With RS facing and using M, pick up and K20[24:28] sts along front of one shoulder (also over sleeve and neck edge). Work in rib back and forth for 1.5 cm. Cast off for 2 buttonholes on next row spacing them 3 sts in from each side. Work buttonhole by casting off 2 sts and 2 new sts above these on following row. Cont in rib for 2 cm. Cast off in rib patt. Repeat for other front shoulder edge.

# **BACK SHOULDER EDGES**

Work as for front omitting buttonholes. Sew on buttons.

# BOOTEES

Footbed measures 7cm long for premature /newborn baby

For a slightly larger size use a bigger needle

[Make 2] Cast on 33 stitches.

Work in Garter Stitch for 16 rows.


Cast off 12 sts at beg of the next 2 rows.

Work 4cm on remaining 9 sts. Cast off.

Take one side of the upper part of the "T" piece and place it on top of the footbed.

Take the other side of the "T" and place it on top of the 2 layers.

Using a yarn needle, sew the bootie together at the toe and the sides.





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
