TEXTURED SWEATER  
SUGAR SPUN

## MEASUREMENTS

Actual Bust Size 97: 101 : 106 cm (38 ¼ : 40 : 41 ¾ in)

## MATERIALS

Cygnets Sugar Spun 100g 3110 Floating Island M 3[4:4] balls and 3660 Fairy Floss C 1 ball

The quantities of yarn stated are based upon average requirements and are therefore approximate.

### Tension:

18 sts and 24 rows to 10 cm [4 in] measured over stocking stitch using 5.5 mm needles.

**VERY IMPORTANT:** IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

If there are less stitches and rows to 10cm, 4in, than the number stated, change to a finer needle, if there are more stitches and rows than stated change to a larger needle.

**NOTES:** Instructions are given for 97 cm, 38 in bust, larger sizes are given in brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes.

Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

Owing to photography and printing restrictions, the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn.

### Knitting Needles:

Sizes 5 mm (US 8) and 5.5 mm (US 9) or the size required to obtain the correct tension.

### Accessories:

Stitch holders

### Abbreviations:

<b>alt</b> alternate	<b>in(s)</b> inch(es)	<b>rept</b> repeat
<b>beg</b> beginning	<b>K</b> knit	<b>rs</b> right side

**Pattern:**

**1<sup>st</sup> row:** (rs) K2, \* P2, K2, rept from \* to end.

**2<sup>nd</sup> row:** P2, \* K2, P2, rept from \* to end.

**3<sup>rd</sup> row:** Knit

**4<sup>th</sup> row:** Purl.

**5<sup>th</sup> row:** as 1<sup>st</sup> row.

**6<sup>th</sup> row:** as 2<sup>nd</sup> row.

**7<sup>th</sup> row:** Purl.

**8<sup>th</sup> row:** Knit

Rept these 8 rows.

**BACK**

With smaller needles and C, cast on 86 (90 : 94 ) sts and work 8 rows in K2, P2 rib. Break off C.

Change to larger needles and using M, proceed in patt as set for 22 (24-26in [56 -61- 66 cm]), ending on a ws row.

**Shape shoulders**

Cast off 16 sts beg next 4 rows.

Leave rem 22 (26-30) sts on a holder.

**FRONT**

Work as given for Back until Front measures 19 (21-23in [48.5 (53.5-58.5) cm]), ending on a ws row.

**Shape left side of neck**

**Next row:** Patt 35 (36- 37), K2tog (neck edge). Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.

**Next row:** Patt

**Next row:** Patt to last 2 sts, K2tog.

**Next row:** Patt.

Rep last 2 rows until 32 sts rem, ending on a ws row.

**Shape shoulder**

**Next row:** cast off 16 sts, patt to end.

**Next row:** Patt.

Cast off rem 16 sts.

With rs facing, slip next 12 (14-16) sts onto a st holder for front neck. Rejoin yarn to rem sts.

**Shape right side of neck**

**Next row:** sl 1, k1 pssso, patt to end.

**Next row:** Patt.

Rep last 2 rows until 32 sts rem ending on a rs row.

**Shape shoulder**

**Next row:** Cast off 16 sts, patt to end.

**Next row:** Patt.

Cast off rem 16 sts.

**SLEEVES**

With smaller needles and C, cast on 34 (38-42) sts and work 8 rows in k2, P2 rib.

Change to larger needles and M, proceed in patt as given for Back for 2 rows.

Keeping continuity of patt, inc 1 st at each end of next and every

folll 3<sup>rd</sup> row until there are 80 (90-100) sts, taking inc sts into patt. Cont straight until Sleeve measures 17 in [43 cm] ending on a ws row. Cast off loosely.

**NECKBND**

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing, using smaller needles and C, pick up and knit 15 sts down left front neck edge, K12 (14-16) sts from front neck st holder. pick up and knit 15 sts up right front neck edge and K22(26 -30) sts from Back neck st holder, inc 2 sts evenly across. 66 (72 -78) sts. Work 7 rows in K2, P2 rib. Cast off loosely in rib.

**FINISHING**

Join left shoulder and neckband seam.

Place markers on side edges of Front and Back 9 (10-11) in [23 (25.5-28) cm] down from shoulders.

Sew cast off edge of sleeves between markers on body, placing centre of sleeve to shoulder seam.

Join side and sleeve seams.



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
