

CY1848
TEXTURED SWEATER
SUGAR SPUN

MEASUREMENTS

Actual Bust Size 97: 101:106 cm (38 1/4: 40:41 1/4 in)

MATERIALS

Cygnet Sugar Spun 100g 3110 Floating Island M 3[4:4] balls and 3660 Fairy Floss C 1 ball

The quantities of yarn stated are based upon average requirements and are therefore approximate.

Tension:

18 sts and 24 rows to 10 cm [4 in] measured over stocking stitch using 5.5 mm needles.

VERY IMPORTANT: IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

If there are less stitches and rows to 10cm, 4in, than the number stated, change to a finer needle, if there are more stitches and rows than stated change to a larger needle.

NOTES: Instructions are given for 97 cm, 38 in bust, larger sizes are given in brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes.

Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

Owing to photography and printing restrictions, the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn.

Knitting Needles:

Sizes 5 mm (US 8) and 5.5 mm (US 9) or the size required to obtain the correct tension.

Accessories:

Stitch holders

Abbreviations:

| alt alternate | in(s) inch(es) | rept repeat |
|-------------------|----------------|----------------------|
| beg beginning | K knit | rs right side |
| cm centimetres | P purl | st(s) stitch(es) |
| cont continue | rem remaining | tog together |
| dec decrease(ing) | rept repeat | ws wrong sid |

foll following rs right side

inc increase(ing)
st(s) stitch(es)

Pattern:

1st row: (rs) K2, * P2, K2, rept

from * to end.

2nd row: P2, * K2, P2, rept from *

to end.

3rd row: Knit **4th row:** Purl.

5th row: as 1st row. 6th row: as 2nd row.

7th row: Purl. **8th row:** Knit Rept these 8 rows.

BACK

With smaller needles and C, cast on 86 (90:94) sts and work 8 rows in K2, P2 rib. Break off C. Change to larger needles and using M, proceed in patt as set for 22 (24-26in [56-61-66 cm], ending on a ws row.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 16 sts beg next 4 rows. Leave rem 22 (26-30) sts on a holder.

FRONT

Work as given for Back until Front measures 19 (21-23in [48.5 (53.5-58.5) cm], ending on a ws row.

Shape left side of neck

Next row: Patt 35 (36-37), K2tog (neck edge). Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.

Next row: Patt

Next row: Patt to last 2 sts,

K2tog.

Next row: Patt.

Rep last 2 rows until 32 sts rem,

ending on a ws row. **Shape shoulder**

Next row: cast off 16 sts, patt to

end.

Next row: Patt. Cast off rem 16 sts.

With rs facing, slip next 12 (14-16) sts onto a st holder for front neck. Rejoin yarn to rem sts.

Shape right side of neck

Next row: sl 1, k1 psso, patt to

end.

Next row: Patt.

Rep last 2 rows until 32 sts rem

ending on a rs row. Shape shoulder

Next row: Cast off 16 sts, patt to

end.

Next row: Patt. Cast off rem 16 sts.

SLEEVES

With smaller needles and C, cast on 34 (38-42) sts and work 8 rows in k2, P2 rib.

Change to larger needles and M, proceed in patt as given for Back for 2 rows.

Keeping continuity of patt, inc 1 st at each end of next and every

foll 3rd row until there are 80 (90-100) sts, taking inc sts into patt. Cont straight until Sleeve measures 17 in [43 cm] ending on a ws row. Cast off loosely.

NECKBND

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing, using smaller needles and C, pick up and knit 15 sts down left front neck edge, K12 (14-16) sts from front neck st holder. pick up and knit 15 sts up right front neck edge and K22(26 -30) sts from Back neck st holder, inc 2 sts evenly across. 66 (72 -78) sts. Work 7 rows in K2, P2 rib. Cast off loosely in rib.

FINISHING

Join left shoulder and neckband seam.

Place markers on side edges of Front and Back 9 (10-11) in [23 (25.5-28) cm] down from shoulders.

Sew cast off edge of sleeves between markers on body, placing centre of sleeve to shoulder seam.

Join side and sleeve seams.
