CAP SLEEVED BABY CARDIGAN
BOHO SPIRIT

MEASUREMENTS

To Fit Chest 3[6,12,18,24] Months

Actual Measurement 48[51,56,60,62]cm

MATERIALS

Cygnet Boho Spirit 100g 6943 Dream 1[1,1,2,2] Balls

A pair of 3.75 mm and 4.5 mm (US 5 and US7) Knitting needles.

4 buttons

The quantities of yarn stated are based upon average requirements and are therefore approximate.

NOTES: Instructions are given for 48 cm, larger sizes are given in brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes.

Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

Owing to photography and printing restrictions, the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn.

TENSION:

19 sts and 44 rows to 10 cm (4 in) measured over garter st using 4.5 mm needles If your tension is too tight use a larger needle, if too loose use a smaller needle

VERY IMPORTANT: IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

BODY (WORKED IN ONE PIECE)

Right Front

Using 4.5 mm needles cast on 23[24,26,28,29] sts and work in g st (every row knit) until work measures 1.5[2.5,1.5,1.5,2] cm.

Next row (rs) 1^{st} buttonhole: K2, K2tog, yo, K to end. Cont in g st until work measures 6.5[8,8,8.5,9] cm. **Next row** (rs) 2^{nd} buttonhole: K2, K2tog, yo, K to end. Cont in g st until work measures 11.5[13.5,14.5,15.5,16] cm.

Next row (rs) 3rd buttonhole: K2, K2tog, yo, K to end.

Cont in g st until work measures 15[17,19,21,22]cm, ending on a RS row.

Armhole

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next ws row. 21[22,24,26,27] sts.

Next row (rs) dec row: K to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2. 20[21,23,25,26] sts

Rept this dec row on foll rs row. 19[20,22,24,25] sts

Work 1 row straight.

Next row (rs) 4th buttonhole: k2, k2tog, yo, k to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2. 18[19,21,23,24] sts.

Cont until work measures 18[20,22,24,25] cm, ending on a ws row.

Neck

Row 1: (rs, dec row) K2, K2tog, K to end.

Row 2: (ws, dec row) K to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2. 16[17,19,21,22] sts.

** Sizes 3, 6 and 12 months only

Rept rows 1-2, 4 times more. 8[9,11]sts

Size 18 months only

Rept rows 1-2, 4 times more. Rept row 1 once more. 12 sts

Size 24 months only

Rept rows 1-2, 5 times more. 12 sts

All sizes

Cont in g st on rem 8[9,11,12,12] sts until work measures 25[28,31,33,35]cm.

Back neck

Cont in g st until work measures 27[30,33,35,37] cm. **

Cast on 15[16,16,17,19] sts at end of next ws row.

Leave the 23[25,27,29,31] sts on a spare needle.

Left Front

Using $4\frac{1}{2}$ mm needles cast on 23[24,26,28,29] sts and cont in g st until work measures 15[17,19,21,22] cm.

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next RS row.

Work 1 row straight.

Next row (rs dec) K2, k2tog, K to end.

Rept this dec row on every RS row twice more.

Cont on rem 18[19,21,23,24] sts until work measures 18[20,22,24,25] cm, ending on a WS row.

Neck

Row 1 (rs, dec) K to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2.

Row 2 (ws, dec) K2, K2tog, K to end.

Work from ** to ** as given for Right Front but working the 2 dec rows as above.

Back

With rs facing, K across 9[9,11,12,12] sts of left front, then on same needle, k across 23[25,27,29,31] sts of right front. 31[34,38,41,43] sts.

Cont in g st until work measures 6[7,8,8,9] cm from start of back neck.

Armholes

Next row (RS, inc row) K2, inc 1, k to last 2 sts, inc 1, K2.

Rept this inc row on every foll RS row twice more, then cast on 2 sts at beg of foll 2 rows. 41[44,48,51,53] sts.

Cont until work measures 23[26,29,31,33] cm from start of back neck ending with a WS row facing. Cast off all sts knitwise.

SLEEVES

Using 3.75 mm needles cast on 47[52,57,62,67]sts and K2 rows. **Next row** (RS) K2, K2tog, k to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2. 45[50,55,60,65]sts. Rept this dec row on every row to 21[26,31,36,41] sts. Cast off.

MAKING UP

Sew the sleeves into the vertical part of the armholes gathering the tops of the sleeves. The cap sleeve fits within the straight edge part of the armhole. Ensure you don't join it all the way around. First, pin the sleeve in place, gathering as you go. Adjust the gathers until they are even, then sew in place.

Join side seams. Sew on buttons.

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
