Materials

1 x Grousemoor Aran Grey Fleck 4424 (MC)

1 x Grousemoor Aran White 208 (CC1)

1 x Grousemoor Aran Black 217 (CC2)

5mm Crochet Hook

Safety Toy stuffing

Stitch Marker

Tapestry Needle

Large safety eyes

Tension

Tension is not important as long as you maintain the same tension throughout.

Sizing

Approx. 66 cm tall.

Abbreviations

This pattern is written in UK Crochet terms

Rnd Round

Ch Chain

St Stitch

Dc Double Crochet

Dc2tog Work 2 dc stitches together; Insert hook in to next st, yo, pull yarn through, then insert hook in to next stitch, yo, pull through, yo, pull through three loops on hook.

Slst Slip Stitch

Place a stitch marker at the beginning of each row so you don't lose your place.

Body

This section is worked in the amigurumi style, in a spiral without slip stitching or turning chains.

With 5mm hook and MC.

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)

Rnd 3: *dc, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnd 4: *dc into next two sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (24sts)

Rnd 5: *dc into next three sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (30sts)

Rnd 6: *dc into next four sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (36sts)

Rnd 7: *dc into next five sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (42sts)

Rnd 8: *dc into next six sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (48sts)

Rnd 9: *dc into next seven sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (54sts)

Rnd 10: *dc into next eight sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (60sts)

Rnd 11: *dc into next nine sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (66sts)

Rnd 12: *dc into next ten sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (72sts)

Rnd 13: *dc into next eleven sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (78sts)

Rnd 14: *dc into next twelve sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (84sts)

Rnds 15-16: Dc around.

Rnd 17: *dc into next thirteen sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (90sts)

Rnds 18-34: Dc around.

Rnd 35: *dc into next thirteen sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (84sts)

Rnd 36: Dc around.

Rnd 37: *dc into next twelve sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (78sts)

Rnd 38: Dc around.

Rnd 39: *dc into next eleven sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (72sts)

Rnds 40-41: Dc around.

Stuff and continue to stuff as you go.

Rnd 42: *dc into next ten sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (66sts)

Rnds 43-44: Dc around

Rnd 45: *dc into next nine sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (60sts)

Rnds 46-49: Dc around

Rnd 50: *dc into next eight sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (54sts)

Rnds 51-53: Dc around

Rnd 54: *dc into next seven sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (48sts)

Rnds 55-56: Dc around

Rnd 57: *dc into next six sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (42sts)

Rnds 58-59: Dc around

Rnd 60: *dc into next five sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (36sts)

Rnd 61: *dc into next four sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (30sts)

Fasten off.

Head

The head is created in two sections the main head and then the upper jaw that is stretched over the main head.

Main Head

This section is worked in the amigurumi style, in a spiral without slip stitching or turning chains.

Starting at the back of the head.

With 5mm hook and CC1;

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)

Rnd 3: *dc, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnd 4: *dc into next two sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (24sts)

Rnd 5: *dc into next three sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (30sts)

Rnd 6: *dc into next four sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (36sts)

Rnd 7: *dc into next five sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (42sts)

Rnd 8: *dc into next six sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (48sts)

Rnd 9: *dc into next seven sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (54sts)

Rnds 10-11: Dc around.

Rnd 12: *dc into next eight sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (60sts)

Rnds 13-20: Dc around.

Rnd 21: *dc into next eight sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (54sts)

Rnds 22-25: Dc around.

Rnd 26: *dc into next seven sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (48sts)

Rnds 27-28: Dc around.

Rnd 29: *dc into next six sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (42sts)

Rnds 30-32: Dc around.

Stuff and continue to stuff as you go.

Rnd 33: *dc into next five sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (36sts)

Rnds 34-35: Dc around.

Rnd 36: *dc into next four sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (30sts)

Rnds 37-38: Dc around.

Rnd 39: *dc into next three sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (24sts)

Rnd 40: *dc into next two sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnd 36: *dc into next st, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (12sts)

Thread yarn through sts and pull tight.

Upper Jaw

This section is started in the amigurumi style, in a spiral without slip stitching or turning chains, and is then worked in rows with the turning chain not counted.

With 5mm hook and MC;

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)

Rnd 3: *dc, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnd 4: *dc into next two sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (24sts)

Rnd 5: *dc into next three sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (30sts)

Rnd 6: *dc into next four sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (36sts)

Rnd 7: *dc into next five sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (42sts)

Rnd 8: *dc into next six sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (48sts)

Rnd 9: *dc into next seven sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (54sts)

Rnds 10-11: Dc around.

Rnd 12: *dc into next eight sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (60sts)

Rnds 13-22: Dc around.

Rnd 23: *dc into next eight sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (54sts)

Rnds 24-26: Dc around.

Rnd 27: Dc around, turn.

Now working on the next 33 sts in rows;

Row 1: Ch1, [dc in next 7 sts, dc2tog] three times, dc in next 6 sts, turn. (30sts)

Rows 2-5: Ch1, dc across.

Row 6: Ch1, dc in next ten sts, dc2tog, dc in next six sts, dc2tog, dc in next ten sts, turn. (28 sts)

Row 7: Ch1, dc across.

Row 8: Ch1, dc in next ten sts, dc2tog, dc in next four sts, dc2tog, dc in next ten sts, turn. (26 sts)

Row 9: Ch1, dc across.

Row 10: Ch1, dc in next nine sts, dc2tog, dc in next four sts, dc2tog, dc in next nine sts, turn. (24 sts)

Row 11: Ch1, dc in next eight sts, dc2tog, dc in next four sts, dc2tog, dc in next eight sts, turn. (22 sts)

Row 12: Ch1, dc in next seven sts, dc2tog, dc in next four sts, dc2tog, dc in next seven sts, turn. (20 sts)

Row 13: Ch1, dc in next six sts, dc2tog, dc in next four sts, dc2tog, dc in next six sts, turn. (18 sts)
Row 14: Ch1, dc in next five sts, dc2tog, dc in next four sts, dc2tog, dc in next five sts, turn. (16 sts)
Rows 15-20: Dc across.
Row 21: Ch1, dc in next four sts, dc2tog, dc in next four sts, dc2tog, dc in next four sts, turn. (14 sts)
Row 22: Ch1, dc in next three sts, dc2tog, dc in next four sts, dc2tog, dc in next three sts, turn. (12 sts)
Row 23: Ch1, [dc2tog] six times. (6 sts)
Thread yarn through stitches and pull tight.

Nose

This section is worked in rows, the turning chains do not count as stitches.

With CC2:

Chain 11.

Row 1; Starting in 2nd ch from hook, dc across, turn. (10sts)

Row 2: Ch1, dc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch1, [dc2tog] five times, turn. (5sts)

Row 4: Ch1, dc across, turn.

Row 5: Ch1, dc2tog, dc, dc2tog, turn. (3sts)

Row 6: Ch1, dc2tog, dc, turn. (2sts)

Row 7: Ch1, dc2tog. (1st)

Fasten off.

Legs

Make 4 the same.

This section is worked in the amigurumi style, in a spiral without slip stitching or turning chains.

With 5mm hook and CC1;

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)

Rnd 3: *dc, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnd 4: *dc into next two sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (24sts)

Rnd 5: Dc around.

Rnd 6: *dc into next three sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (30sts)

Rnds 7-9: Dc around.

Rnd 10: *dc into next three sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (24sts)

Rnd 11: Dc around.

Rnd 12: *dc into next two sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnd 13: Dc around.

Change to MC.

Stuff and continue to stuff as you go.

Rnds 14-48: Dc around.

Fasten off.

Tail

This section is worked in the amigurumi style, in a spiral without slip stitching or turning chains.

Starting at the tip.

With 5mm hook and CC1;

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)

Rnds 2-3: Dc around.

Rnd 4: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)

Rnd 5: Dc around.

Rnd 6: *dc, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnd 7: *dc into next two sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (24sts)

Rnd 8: Dc around.

Rnd 9: *dc into next three sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (30sts)

Rnds 10-11: Dc around

Change to MC.

Stuff and continue to stuff as you go.

Rnds 12-16: Dc around

Rnd 17: *dc into next three sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (24sts)

Rnds 18-26: Dc around.

Rnd 27: *dc into next two sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnds 28-41: Dc around.

Fasten off.

Ears

Make 2 the same.

This section is worked in the amigurumi style, in a spiral without slip stitching or turning chains.

With 5mm hook and MC;

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)

Rnds 2-3: Dc around.

Rnd 4: 2dc in first st, dc, 2dc in next two sts, dc, 2dc in last st. (10sts)

Rnd 5: 2dc in first st, dc in next three sts, 2dc in next two sts, dc in next three sts, 2dc in last st. (14sts)

Rnd 6: Dc around.

Rnd 7: 2dc in first st, dc in next five sts, 2dc in next two sts, dc in next five sts, 2dc in last st. (18sts)

Rnd 8: 2dc in first st, dc in next seven sts, 2dc in next two sts, dc in next seven sts, 2dc in last st. (22sts)

Rnds 9-15: Dc around.

Fasten off.

Teeth

Make 2 the same.

This section is worked in rows, the turning chains do not count as stitches.

With CC1:

Chain 7.

Row 1; Starting in 2nd ch from hook, dc across, turn. (6sts)

Row 2: Ch1, dc across.

Row 3: Ch1, dc2tog, dc across, turn. (5sts)

Row 4: Ch1, dc2tog, dc across, turn. (4sts)

Row 5: Ch1, dc2tog, dc across, turn. (3sts)

Row 6: Ch1, dc2tog, dc across, turn. (2sts)

Row 7: Ch1, dc2tog. (1sts)

Fasten off.

Making Up

Attach the safety eyes to the upper jaw section of the head, when the rows begin, each approx. 1 inch from the centre. Stretch the upper jaw section over the main head, attach the teeth to either side just under the upper jaw and then secure the upper jaw in place. Attach the nose to the front, and the ears to the top of the head and equal distance from the eyes. Attach the top of the body to the head. Attach the opening of two of the legs at either side of the body

where it joins the head and the other two to the base of the body. Attach the opening of the tail to the base of the body in the centre of the back. Weave in any lose ends.
